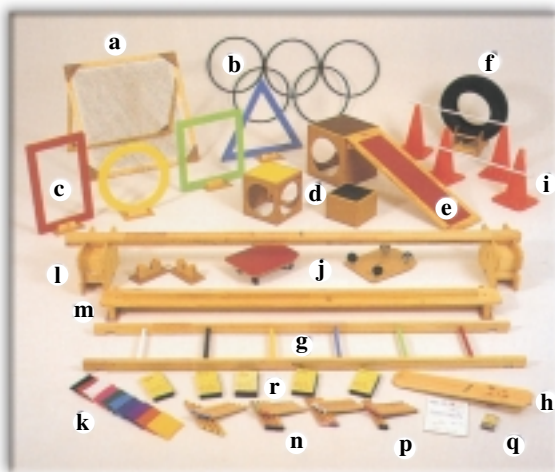

The Distance Program was established primarily to help parents, in rural areas, help their children avoid difficulties in learning at school.
